Subject: West Virginia CDBG-DR Action Plan Amendment Grant Agreement

The Department approved the State of West Virginia's Action Plan Amendment #1, which was submitted on October 17, 2017. The State of West Virginia administers the Community Development Block Grant disaster recovery (CDBG-DR) funds appropriated under the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2017 Public Law (P.L.) 115-31 for \$400 million. The previous allocations under Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2016 (P.L. 114-223), enacted September 2, 2016, and (P.L. 114-254), enacted December 10, 2016, have been combined with this award and will be administered as one grant for a total amount of \$149,875,000 for the 2016 disaster under grant number B-16-DL-54-0001.

This action assigns an additional \$45,595,000 to the State of West Virginia under P.L. 115-31 as identified in the August 7, 2017 *Federal Register* Notice (82 FR 36812). The combined amount is reflected in the enclosed grant agreement. To obligate these funds, please print three copies, sign, and return each original copy for HUD's signature via express mail. The date that is reflected on the grant agreement is the date of which the funds are obligated. All funds obligated by the grant agreement must be expended within six years of the date on which the Department signed the previous grant agreement. Please note, special grant terms and conditions for the use of these funds are also enclosed.


The State's CDBG-DR line of credit is accessible through HUD's Disaster Recovery Grant Reporting (DRGR) system. While the State has several users established in the DRGR system, please contact HUD Rep Jill K. Moyer to have other users registered or to resolve any DRGR access issues. Please be advised that the State of West Virginia is required to report on its use of CDBG-DR funds outlined in the updated Action Plan through the DRGR system. The DRGR reporting requirements are outlined in detail in the Department's applicable *Federal Register* Notices.

Upon receipt, the grant agreement will be executed by the Department, and a copy will be returned for your files. The date that the Department signed the previous grant agreement was September 15, 2017, which is also the obligation date for these combined funds. All funds obligated by this grant agreement must be expended within six years. Additionally, the State's

line of credit for this grant will be established once the funds have been obligated. The State's CDBG-DR line of credit is accessible through HUD's Disaster Recovery Grant Reporting (DRGR) system.
